Diversinet Corp. has introduced a secure text messaging application to support mobile communication between patients and providers.

The MobiSecure SMS product is targeted for telehealth and case/disease management programs. The service includes unique authentication using one-time passwords, encryption, remote wiping of data if a mobile device is stolen or lost, and message lengths of up to 1,400 characters, according to the Toronto-based vendor. The application also offers delivery and read-receipt confirmation messages to users.
